



Number of companies receiving more than 20 reports




#### Turkish TV news dedicated to reporting on education










#### Bild eclipses all other dailies






#### Spiegel attracted most attention in political sections






#### Bild is strong in the economy section as well






#### **Spiegel** quotations placed most prominently






#### Architecture puts UAE on the world map










#### G20 countries with a very mixed profile








#### Violence: Who is Involved?


